SRI PRASANNA CHENNAKESAVA SWAMY

The temple's main deity is Chenna Kesava Perumal, an incarnation of Lord Vishnu, representing spiritual energy. The temple showcases the magnificence of Dravidian architecture with intricate carvings on its walls and pillars. The temple features unique stone chariots and musical pillars, enhancing its artistic brilliance. The presence of Goddess Lakshmi, the divine consort of Lord Vishnu, symbolizes prosperity and grace, adding to the spiritual significance of the temple.



VODAREVU BEACH

Vodarevu Beach is a popular tourist spot located in the Bapatla district of Andhra Pradesh, India, near Chirala, known for its tranquil atmosphere, coconut trees, and stunning views of the Bay of Bengal. Visitors can enjoy boat rides, fishing, and various water sports, making it a favorite weekend destination from Hyderabad. The best time to visit is during the winter months, from October to March, for pleasant weather.

BHAIRAVAKONA

Bhairavakona is a sacred pilgrimage site located near the town of Ongole in Prakasam District of Andhra Pradesh, India. Known for its historical and religious significance, Bhairavakona features ancient rock-cut temples carved during the 7th century. Nestled amidst the Nallamala hills, the place is renowned for the majestic Bhairavakona waterfalls which cascade down the rocks, creating a serene ambiance. The temples are dedicated to various Hindu deities and exhibit the architectural brilliance of the Pallava and Chola periods. Bhairavakona is not just a spiritual retreat but also an archaeological gem attracting historians and tourists alike. The intricate carvings, inscriptions, and the picturesque location amidst natural beauty make Bhairavakona an unforgettable visit.





KOTHAPATNAM BEACH

Kothapatnam Beach is located near the town of Kothapatnam, close to Ongole. The beach is popular among locals and tourists for its serene ambiance and the picturesque coastline it offers. SRI SHIRDI SAI BABA MANDIR

Sri Shirdi Sai Baba Mandir in Ongole, a city in the Prakasam District of Andhra Pradesh, India, stands as a spiritual sanctuary paying homage to the legendary saint Sai Baba of Shirdi. The temple exhibits simple yet serene architecture, drawing devotees from various parts of the state and neighboring regions. It is an abode of peace and spirituality where visitors can immerse themselves in the teachings and blessings of Sai Baba. The temple is adorned with his idol and pictures, creating an environment conducive to meditation and prayer. The premises are well maintained, offering a clean and composed space, fostering a sense of calm and introspection among the pilgrims.

GUNDLAKAMMA RESERVOIR

Gundlakamma Reservoir, located near Ongole in Andhra Pradesh, India, is an important water source for irrigation and local needs. Constructed on the Gundlakamma River, the reservoir serves a dual purpose of flood control and agriculture. The vast expanse of water with the backdrop of distant hills offers a serene and picturesque setting. The area surrounding the reservoir includes lush greenery and agricultural fields, reflecting the verdancy boosted by this crucial water body. Visitors can enjoy the tranquility of the waterbody and the surrounding natural beauty. It is a preferred spot for picnics and a leisurely day out.



CHIRALA WEAVES

Chirala weaves are traditional handloom fabrics, primarily cotton and silk, originating from the town of Chirala in Andhra Pradesh, India, and known for their feather-light, soft texture and fine craftsmanship. Weavers in Chirala have a long history of producing intricate fabrics, including lightweight cotton sarees perfect for daily wear and other furnishing fabrics, using traditional pit looms and natural dyes.

SRIGIRI TEMPLE

Srigiri, a special temple of Lord Venkata Chalapathy located on the hill Srigiri, in Ongole, prakasam District, Andhra Pradesh, India. This temple was built with a special message from the divine, made possible through the wholehearted efforts of the family. The significance of the temple aroused from its simplicity and disciplines followed with utmost attention paid to the tradition in all of its programs. Besides the holy sanctum of the temple with its special mend of Garuda aakara (Eagle shaped architecture of temple), the maha murthy (Main Statue) is observed to be carved in Omkaara Sila – a special type of stone that gives the sound of Om when touched, and with almost of equal in size to Shri Venkata Chalapathy of Tirumala- Tirupati
